Tuition Assistance Program

for Home School and Catholic School Families with children in Grades One through Eight is in effect for the coming school year. Forms are available in the back of Church.

To qualify for this tuition assistance you must:

- be a registered, regular (not associate) member of the parish for at least one year prior to the beginning of the 2010-2011 school year;
- attend Sunday Mass at St. Martin of Tours on a regular basis
- contribute to the parish, to the extent possible, of your Time, Talent and Treasure;
- be in genuine financial need of this tuition assistance.
